

## **PROCEEDINGS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF DUBROVNIK – INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS**

Proceedings of the University of Dubrovnik is an international peer reviewed journal that publishes scientific papers from all scientific and artistic fields.

It is issued once a year with a circulation of 150 copies.

The access to the published papers is free (no article processing charges & no article submission charges).

Papers are generally published in Croatian or in English. However, papers written in other languages can be published as well.

Papers are double-blind peer reviewed and are classified in the following categories:

- original scientific paper (contains the hitherto unpublished results of the original scientific research)
- preliminary communication (contains new results of scientific research whose prompt publication is useful)
- review (contains original, concise, and critical review of the author's field of work, and gives its contribution to the already published papers)
- presentation from the scientific conference (previously presented at the scientific conference which has not been published in the conference proceedings as an article)
- professional paper (contains useful contributions from a specific profession and does not have to be an original research).

Papers sent to the Editorial Board have to meet the following criteria:

- each paper must be original and unpublished,
- letterhead contains the author's name and surname, title and vocation, name and address of the institution of employment, e-mail address, as well as clear and informative title. Data must be written in Croatian and English or in English and Croatian if the paper is written in English. Papers written in other languages should contain basic information in English as well,
- scope should not exceed 20 pages (about 40000 characters),
- abstract should be written below the paper title in the same language as the paper; it should contain up to 150 words/15 lines with the content of the paper and research results briefly described in the third person,
- three to five key words are written below the abstract,
- authors are advised to write the titles and subtitles in the same font as the text, and not to indent the titles as the text will be graphically edited and adjusted to the Proceedings layout,
- tables must be clear and properly prepared and described (number, title, legend),
- figures should be prepared either in JPG or TIFF format ( grayscale resolution of 300 ppi), with size and complexity adapted to the format of the Proceedings (B5) so that all elements could be clearly seen; the photos are required to have high offsetting quality.
- authors are required to adhere to the scientific methodology when presenting the materials/writing text which is common to scientific publications („Harvard style“),

- translation of abstract and key words must be submitted after the references.
- to avoid the author's withdrawal from publishing the paper in the review process, the author signs the „Copyright Transfer Statement“ and thereby accepts the review procedure. The author's signature confirms the originality and authorship of the article.
- Papers must meet all technical requirements listed in these instructions.

The Editorial Board reserves the right to adjust the paper to the editorial standards of the journal and to proofread the texts written in Croatian according to the standards of the Croatian language.
