

## INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

1. The journal Veterinar publishes articles in Croatian and English, of Croatian and foreign students and experts of veterinary medicine, as well as students and experts in the field of biomedicine, healthcare and biotechnology. The institution where the author studies/works should also be listed along with the authors.
2. Original scientific works, case reports, expert and overview articles, expert discussions, summaries of works, popularizing articles and other texts on scientific and professional topics are published. In the same way, the magazine can also contain notifications, announcements and reviews of past events.
3. Texts should be written in MS Word, Times New Roman font, font size 12 pt, spacing 1.5. The article must contain a minimum of 2 cards of text, and a maximum of 10 cards, not including images and attachments. Exceptionally, longer texts will be published if the editors think it is necessary for a complete presentation of the content of the work. Abstracts may contain a maximum of 300 words and a maximum of 6 keywords.
4. The text tab contains 1500 characters with spaces.
5. Papers in English must be accompanied by the title of the paper and abstract in Croatian, while papers in Croatian must be accompanied by the title and abstract in English.
6. Pictures and attachments are attached separately. Three-dimensional graphs and attachments that are unimportant or less important for the presentation of the work should be avoided. Images and attachments must contain a serial number, title and source according to the rules of citing references. The names and descriptions of the pictures are always written below the picture and the names and descriptions of the tables are above the table. The place where images and attachments need to be inserted must be indicated in the text.
7. Images should be of minimum 1MB/300 dpi quality. Graphs and tables should be tabulated in MS Excel.
8. If you use illustrations or tables taken from other authors' publications in your work, you must cite the exact source (copyright protection), and in most cases obtain permission from the publisher to use that material (copyright protection).
9. In the text itself, cited authors and the year of publication are stated as follows:
  - a) if there is one author: LEVETT (1982.)
  - b) if there are two authors: SMITH AND WESSON (2005.),
  - c) if there are three or more authors: HOLMES et al. (1919.),
  - d) if the text cites several authors, they are listed in the order of the year of publication: VAN VALKENBURGH (1989.); POPOWICS (2003.),
  - e) publications by the same authors and the same years EVANS AND SANSON, (2005.a); EVANS AND SANSON (2005.b)
10. Title of journals are abbreviated according to the International List of Journal Title Abbreviations (for help, see *Web of Science Journal Title Abbreviations*)
11. References are listed at the end of the article in alphabetical order. Only references cited in the text are listed, as follows:

14. If the paper was previously published in another journal, it cannot be republished in the *Veterinar*.

16. The editorial office, at the author's request, delivers one printed version of the magazine to each author.
