

Guidelines for references

References in the footnotes should be given in abridged form, leaving the full form for the bibliography at the end of the paper.

✓ *In the footnotes:*

author's surname (name initial, if needed), year of publication of the book/article, page number, e.g.

BOLONIĆ 1980, 150–167.

BOLONIĆ – ŽIC–ROKOV 1977, 55.

ZMAJIĆ 1970, 255–257.

✓ *In the bibliography:*

BOLONIĆ, Mihovil, *Otok Krk – kolijevka glagoljice*, Zagreb: Kršćanska sadašnjost, 1980.

BOLONIĆ, Mihovil – ŽIC–ROKOV, Ivan, *Otok Krk kroz vjekove*, Zagreb: Kršćanska sadašnjost, 1977.

ZMAJIĆ, Bartol, Grbovi Krčkih knezova, kasnijih Frankopana, *Krčki zbornik 1 (1970): 255–257.*

Works by the same author published in the same year are designated by small letters, e.g. the first – 2021a, the second – 2021b, etc.

Entries in the bibliography are cited in alphabetical order by author surnames, whereas multiple works by the same author are cited chronologically.

Archival materials and unprinted sources come first in the bibliography, followed by previously printed sources and literature.

✓ *Citation of archival sources:*

sources, i.e. archival materials, will be cited both in the main text and in the footnotes as follows: name of the safekeeping institution, name of the stock or collection, number of the series/box/bundle/file/page, e.g.

Croatian State Archives (hereinafter CSA), Collection of the oldest Croatian charters (*Monumenta antiquissima*), sign. 876, no. 7.
