

Notes for references

Authors cited in the text should give their surname and the year of publication in brackets, e.g. (surname, year) or (surname, year, page x), where x is the page number of the citation. In the bibliography, the authors are listed in alphabetical order and, if necessary, in chronological order. Multiple references by the same author from the same year should be marked with the letters 'a', 'b', 'c' etc. next to the year, e.g. (Surname, 2010a) and (Surname, 2010b). The bibliography should be placed at the end of the article and written in Calibri font, size 10, with one space. The hanging indent should be 0.5 cm (0.2"). The paragraph spacing should be 6 pt. Examples of the most common types of references are: a book (Tourangeau, Conrad, Couper, 2013, p. 52), a journal article (Skitka, Sargis, 2006), a journal article with more than three authors (Shukor et al., 2014), an article in the proceedings of a scientific conference (Steingartner, Novitzká, 2015) and a website (" Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0", 2008). For other types of references, it is necessary to follow the APA standard for citing references at www.apastyle.org. Any source cited in the text must be included in the bibliography (and vice versa).
