NATURA CROATICA Review process

Natura Croatica maintains the peer-review process in assessing the manuscripts, and tries to hold to the highest standards of review. The review is single blind, peer-reviewed by independent, anonymous expert referees. Only manuscripts that meet the scientific and journal technical criteria are sent to the referees.

Submissions are possible through the official e-mail natura.croatica@hpm.hr. Usually at least two reviewers process each article, without any charges to the authors and to the journal. During revision process the secretary of the Editorial Board communicates with reviewers and authors, forwarding the information regarding revision. Only Editor in Chief can accept or decline the article. There is no article processing charge.

Upon acceptance, the article is proofread by an English language expert, the manuscript is additionally checked once again, and pre-print article PDF file is prepared by the secretary of the Editorial Board for publishing papers as 'online first'. Digital Object Identifier (DOI) number is assigned and registered. Final article PDF file is then prepared and the article is published online (usually June 30 and December 31) at HRČAK website, and at the Natura Croatica webpage at the publisher – Croatian Natural History Museum. Before publication the corresponding author is asked to check the version prepared for publication. Supplementary article materials can be available only online.
